Introduzione

Bertrand Russel, filosofo, logico e matematico, e' stato un autore prolifico e poliedrico, che si e' occupato dei fondamenti della matematica, della geometria e della logica; di filosofia della conoscenza; di etica; di politica; di sociologia.

Per limitare l'estensione di questa bibliografia si e' quindi deciso di restringere il campo di ricognizione trascurando le opere di carattere piu' etico e di impegno politico e sociale. Si e' anche deciso di prendere in considerazione solo le opere dell'autore, tralasciando le opere di terzi sull'autore e quelle in risposta ad argomentazioni dello stesso.

Brevi cenni sulla vita del filosofo

Bertrand Arthur William Russell (Ravenscroft, 18 maggio 1876 – Penrhynedeudraeth, 2 febbraio 1970) è stato un filosofo, logico e matematico gallese.

Fu anche un autorevole esponente del movimento pacifista e un divulgatore della filosofia.

Dal 1890, Russell studiò filosofia e logica presso l'università di Cambridge. Nel 1908 divenne assistente al Trinity College. Nel 1920, Russell fece un viaggio in Unione Sovietica e successivamente fu invitato per un anno a Pechino. Nel 1921, Russell perse l'incarico presso l'università e si mantenne scrivendo testi divulgativi su fisica etica ed educazione. Insieme alla moglie, nel 1927 fondò la scuola sperimentale di Beacon Hill. Nel 1939 si trasferì negli Stati Uniti per un incarico presso l'UCLA di Los Angeles. Nel 1944 fece ritorno in Inghilterra presso il Trinity College.

Al sopraggiungere della morte, Russell era anche una voce autorevole nel campo della morale e dell'etica, conseguentemente alla sua presa di posizione contro le armi nucleari e la guerra americana in Vietnam.

Nel 1950, Russell fu insignito del Premio Nobel per la letteratura "quale riconoscimento ai suoi vari e significativi scritti nei quali egli si erge a campione degli ideali umanitari e della libertà di pensiero".
